SAMUEL Durose - M - HANNAH ~~Durose~~ (1st wife) (U Hoxeter) b. 2.1809
b: 1774 " - M - MARY FOSTER (2nd wife) 3.12.1811 (Bramshall)

Liekeates - of Benton - on - Trent - comes down from

HANNAH - D/o SAMUEL & MARY nee FOSTER
b: 16.12.1814

Hannah was sister to your JOHN 1813.

Seyl Davie - of Kidderminster - comes down from

BENJAMIN s/o JACOB & ANN nee RATCLIFFE

See my F.T.

I think you should note that this Jacob & Ann had 9 SONS & no daughters that we can find!!!

I note - on looking again at your Mormon chart - that you are from THOMAS s/o SAMUEL & HANNAH - who died in 1809 & yes! he did marry her in 1809 too.

THOMAS - M - SARAH BERRISFORD - 9.3.1837 at U Hoxeter by license.
(This from the Staffs. Marriage Index 1500s to 1837.)

Please excuse the confusion - but if you could just see me now - sat at the dining table which is covered with family FT-5 of them - + numerous other papers. I have now so much & so many various papers etc for Demose - that I've had to buy another file just for them alone.

Could you also tell me about Demoses in 1589 & how we connect - if at all - with them.

I was very amused by the 'burglary' news. James must have been reasonably off if he could offer a £5 reward in 1796. I wonder if the items or the felons - were ever caught.

You mentioned that some Demoses are in the US - in Minnesota. Can you tell me more please - we do have friends in Iowa & Wisconsin - so that area is somewhat known to us.
