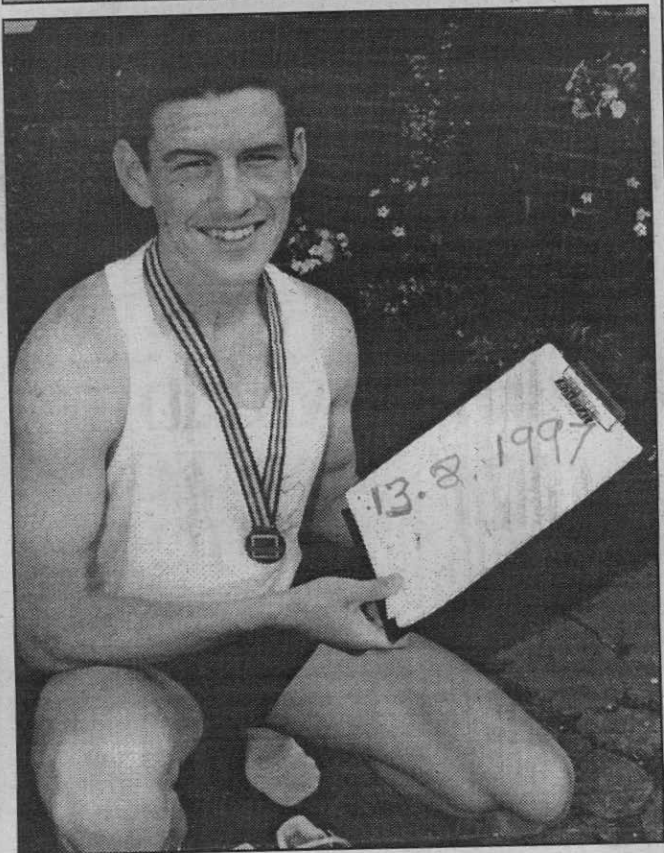


James's running total!
