Consistory Court Wills for the Diocese of Coventry and Lichfield

Names and brief details extracted from selected Durose wills and administrations

1842 Sep 3 Samuel Durose of Kingstone

Will: Samuel Durose of Kingstone, Staffs, bricklayer

... to my wife Mary Durose two pieces or parcels of land or ground called or known by the names of Ferny's Croft or Paddock, and Barley Croft, together with ... messuages, dwelling houses, tenements ... belonging to same, now in occupation of of myself and afternamed persons as Tenants under me: Thomas Harper, Thomas Beard, Thomas Spooner, and John Durose [*George was deleted, and John inserted*] ... subject to payment of interest of £200 which sum is secured by mortgage on said property. After demise of said wife Mary Durose my will is that the same be disposed of in the following manner:

- ... to my daughter Ellen
- ... to my six children issue by my second wife Mary Durose, namely Hannah now the wife of George Heath, John, Ellen, James, Mary Ann and Sarah
- ... to my eldest son George Durose
- ... to my next son John Durose
- ... remainder to be divided equally between all my eight children the issue of both my marriages

Probate granted to John Durose and George Durose 2 Sep 1842

Testator died 21 Apr 1842
